

WE CAN'T WAIT TO SEE YOU!!!

On July 5, 2020, Antioch Missionary Baptist Church will resume in person worship services.

We will worship utilizing a modified order of service, including directed offering and designated dismissal from service.

In order to provide the safest possible environment for our members, we will follow Illinois Department of Public Health guidelines and the following rules:

Anyone entering the church must wear a facemask that covers the mouth and nose.

Keep facemask on at all times while in the church. *

Do not shake hands, hug, or greet each other in ways that break social distancing guidelines.

Do not use the water fountains.

Enter the church and promptly take a seat in the sanctuary.

In the sanctuary, sit next to people from your household or someone you have maintained ongoing, in person, physically close contact with during the stay at home order.

Maintain a distance of at least six feet from any other family/group seated near you.

If you or someone in your family is ill or not feeling well, or you have been exposed to someone who is ill or not feeling well, do not attend in person worship services.

Do not linger or gather in the vestibule or any area outside the sanctuary.

** Children under two years of age are not required to wear masks. The nursery will not be open.*

Illinois Department of Public Health guidelines suggests those most vulnerable to COVID-19, older adults, those undergoing chemo therapy, and those with diabetes, heart disease, lung disease, high blood pressure, asthma, or any condition that compromises the immune system, attend virtual worship services.

Antioch Missionary Baptist Church will live stream worship service each Sunday, in addition to conducting in person worship services.

Church vans will not pick up individuals to attend in person service.

As we prepare to take these next steps in faith, we ask the church to unite in prayer that we might edify the saints and give all glory and honor to God.

Removing hymnals from the pews.

Placing hand sanitizer in conspicuous locations in the church, like near entrances to the sanctuary and in bathrooms.

Cleaning and sanitizing the church after every service.

Eliminating bulletins for the time being.

Having only the designated reader read the plan of salvation.
